## 23/424 Planning

23/424.1 2023/0490/FUL Demolish Outbuilding & Erect 3 bed house at Gaerleat, Trudoxhill

At a previous site visit, councillors saw the large hedge between the neighbouring property and the proposed new site and were happy it would remain as a visual barrier. The previous application plans were incorrectly labelled, showing it facing neighbours, which was unintended also Mendip were not happy with 2 storeys, so applicant decided to resubmit based more on original building. Only 2 downstairs windows, councillors questioned the 'roof windows' on the drawings, which were confirmed as only light tubes, they cannot be seen through. Applicants are happy to engage and discuss any issues further. Existing ridge height is 3.7m, 4.6m is new, applicants expressed they were open to the height being discussed if it were to be an issue.
