23/460 Planning

23/460.1 Erection of Barn & Change of use, 4 Acres Agricultural to Equestrian, Oak Tree Barn Millards Hill

The property in question was formally called Iron Mill Farm, now called Oak Tree Barn. After discussion the council understands that for permitted development, residents normally have to live for 10 years before an agricultural building can be built, which is why planning has been submitted for this structure. Change of use is only 4 acres of whole site (26 acres) and a large barn is necessary to manage the multiple uses of this property – woodland, agriculture and horses. This would add more horses on the highway in the parish, currently a point that the council is attempting to raise awareness of to aid in tackling the speeding and road safety issues.

23/462.1 Highways & 20mph Zone Application (SS)

The 20mph application has been received and verified by highways. The head of traffic engineering for Somerset came to visit – a very positive visit – Trudoxhill fits the criteria for a 20mph zone. Speeding data shows there is an issue that can be acted upon with both approaches to the village being above the desired national average. The cost of the legal work and the road and signage works needed for the 20mph zone should be approximately £2,500. The recommended locations would start on all 3 main roads entering the village. The council are also applying for a grant for SIDS, this will continue in parallel.
