23/469.1 Monopitch Extension to Existing South Elevation, Lawns Farm Foghamshire Lane

The council discussed that although the plans were very simplistic, the design and concept are in keeping with the scale and massing of the building and the surroundings. Furthermore, as it would not be seen by neighbours it was agreed that it did not affect local amenity in any way.

23/469.2 Two-Storey Side Extension, Park Cottage Cheese Hill

Members agreed that these plans have been received previously and that this is an extension to the previously extended right wing to increase the kitchen size. The proportion is sensible with the scale of rest of the property and although the design of the new extension is modern, it sits well within the existing building.

New & Expecting parents policy will be released. New highways contract starts next year. Recycling survey shows 48% of rubbish could be recycled, which is am improvement on last year. Grants available for upgraded household heating, thermal cameras available at libraries. An area of A361 (Cranmore) will be closed for resurfacing. No HS2 savings will come to Somerset. Discussions have been had about industrial zoning along A361.
